



# Creating content subfolders

Customize, organize and classify your content offered to your end-users with sub-categorized folders.

## Two ways to do it:

- 1** Create a **new content folder** and add as many **subfolders** you wish to organize your content offer
- 2** Under an **existing content folder**, you can organize it, **moving your images** to new created **subfolders**

# Creation of folders

The images uploaded as content, can be classified in different folders

Click on **Create New** to add a new folder


